

Chronological List of Elijah's Journeys.

1. Tishbe in Gilead

- Reference: 1 Kings 17:1
 - Elijah's place of origin.
-

2. Samaria

- Reference: 1 Kings 17:1; 18:1
 - Elijah confronts King Ahab and later returns to deliver God's word.
-

3. Brook Kerith (Cherith)

- Reference: 1 Kings 17:2–6
 - Elijah hides during the drought, fed by ravens.
-

4. Zarephath (near Sidon)

- Reference: 1 Kings 17:8–24
 - Elijah stays with a widow; miraculously provides food and raises her son.
-

5. Mount Carmel

- Reference: 1 Kings 18:19–46
 - Site of the dramatic contest with the prophets of Baal.
-

6. Jezreel

- Reference: 1 Kings 18:45–46
 - Elijah flees here after the Mount Carmel victory.
-

7. Beersheba (in Judah)

- Reference: 1 Kings 19:3
 - Elijah flees from Jezebel's threat.
-

8. Wilderness (south of Beersheba)

- Reference: 1 Kings 19:4–8
 - Elijah prays to die under a broom tree; an angel strengthens him.
-

9. Mount Horeb (Mount Sinai)

- Reference: 1 Kings 19:8–18
 - Elijah hears God's still small voice and receives further instructions.
-

10. Field of Naboth in Jezreel

- Reference: 1 Kings 21:17–24
 - Elijah confronts Ahab over Naboth's death.
-

11. Samaria (again)

- Reference: 2 Kings 1
- Elijah prophesies King Ahaziah's death.

12. Gilgal

- Reference: 2 Kings 2:1
 - Elijah begins his final journey with Elisha.
-

13. Bethel

- Reference: 2 Kings 2:2
 - They visit a prophetic community.
-

14. Jericho

- Reference: 2 Kings 2:4
 - Another prophetic center.
-

15. Jordan River

- Reference: 2 Kings 2:6–8
 - Elijah parts the river with his cloak.
-

16. East of the Jordan (exact location unknown)

- Reference: 2 Kings 2:11–12
- Elijah is taken to heaven in a whirlwind and chariot of fire.
